# Why?

- 1. Operation with clear legal authority is:
- more fun (no looking over your shoulder)
- less constrained
- unlikely to involve
- lengthy discussions with police officers
- police custody
- being ejected mid-operation

# Why?

- 2. It's in our interests to:
- be **more visible**, not less!
- not cause IMDA to receive "please explains"

#### SLA

- Hundreds of "Community Use" sites
  - Free for "non-exclusive" community use
  - TOL for exclusive use (costly)
- Hundreds more
  - Empty lots
  - Several islands
  - Land within HDB estates (since March) (all?)
  - Sometimes requires a TOL, but typically free



















#### SLA

- OK with smaller antennas (VHF yagis on rotator) on Community Use sites
- For larger antennas (squid poles etc.)
  - Likely to prefer other sites.
  - May have additional reservations that we can't guess in advance.
  - Propose several sites when you ask.
- Campsites
  - TOLs costly
  - "Antennas will be next to our tents so the use of land is for camping activities. No exclusive use of land."

#### **NParks**

- Parks and Trees Act
  - 2 national parks: Singapore Botanic Gardens, Fort Canning Park
  - 4 Nature reserves: Central Catchment Nature Reserve, Bukit Timah Nature Reserve, Labrador Nature Reserve, Sungei Buloh Wetland Reserve
  - 1 Marine park
- But dozens of other "parks"
- PCN
- Some roadsides

#### **Bukit Timah Summit**

- Not on weekends
  - (N.B. park closed 19:00-07:00 daily)
- We suspect: greatly simplified by his being able to present an IMDA license issued **before** we had NParks consent.
  - This is valuable!
  - Really desirable to avoid "please explains".

# Prohibited acts within public parks

- **5.** No person shall carry out any activity within any public park which he knows or ought reasonably to know
  - (a) causes or may cause alteration, damage or destruction to any property, tree or plant within the public park; or
  - (b) causes or may cause injury to, or the death of, any animal or any other organism within the public park.

# General acts requiring approval

**8.**—(1) No person shall, except with the approval of the Commissioner and in accordance with the terms and conditions of such approval, do any of the following in any national park, nature reserve or public park:

. . .

(e) hang or affix any light, bill, placard, notice or other thing on any plant, tree or structure;

# General acts requiring approval

(2) No person shall, except with the approval of the Commissioner and in accordance with the terms and conditions of such approval, carry out any of the following activities within any public park:

. . .

(k) erect any post, rail, fence, pole, booth, stand, stall or other structure.

#### **NParks**

- Don't yet understand which rules apply where.
- Never a problem to ask.
  - Although sometimes slow/no reply at present.

#### Road Traffic (Motor Vehicles, Construction and Use) Rules Height

- **56.**—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), no vehicle shall exceed 4.0 metres in height.
- (2) The Registrar may, subject to such terms and conditions as he may impose, permit the use of a double-decked vehicle which is more than 4.0 metres but less than 4.5 metres in height.

#### Keep in mind

- I'm always happy to help
  - develop an approach
  - draft key parts of emails
- Desirable to avoid teaching any more police officers that it's illegal to operate an amateur radio station outside home.
- Really desirable to avoid causing "please explains" making their way to IMDA
