

YOTA Contest 2023


- 3 rounds per year, 12 hours each
- Bands: 80m, 40m, 20m, 15m, 10m
- Modes: Modes: CW and SSB
- Categories: All mixed mode
 - Station sponsors: station owners inviting youngsters
- Youngster 25 y/o or less
- Exchange: RS(T) + age
- Scoring:
 - Over 25: 1/3 points
 - Under 25: 10 13 points depending on age
- Multipliers: Different ages worked per band


HG23YOTA Station (Indoor)





Off-Air Contest






